9. Make a pilgrimage to pray at the Western Wall (which was still a military zone after Israeli liberation of the site during the Six Day War) and celebrate the Holiday of Shavuot.
10. The world's largest flag was unfurled. Produced by lover of Israel Grace Galindez Gupana, the flag – featuring the emblem of Jerusalem – cost \$120,000 to make.
11. Because there is no functioning Holy Temple in Jerusalem, Jews are not permitted to provide tithed produce to the Cohanim and Leviim. However, Jews and Jewish companies are still required by Jewish law to take tithes and dispose of them. Modern-day tithes cannot be given to Cohanim and Leviim, but CAN be fed to animals. Companies that tithe their produce provide the fodder for the animals (the animals have been sold to a Cohen to enable them to receive the free produce, which is distributed by the local religious council. Meat consumed by the carnivores is provided by kosher butchers, veterinarians, and fishermen. Incidentally, during Passover, the entire zoo is cleared of chametz - animals are fed matzah rather than bread products, and birds are fed rice.
